**RE: JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BASIC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE,
TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE AND ORDINARY DIPLOMA IN FOREST
INDUSTRIES TECHNOLOGY**

I am pleased to inform you that, you have been selected to join **Basic Technician Certificate, Technician Certificate and Ordinary Diploma in Forest Industries Technology Course** at Forest Industries Training Institute (FITI). Basic Technician Certificate NTA 4 one year, Technician Certificate NTA 5 one year and Ordinary Diploma in Forest Industries Technology NTA 6 one year. This course will commencing on 21st October 2018. The following instructions are provided for your guidance and you are requested to read them very carefully before you come to the Institute. Upon arrival you will be issued with the Institutes rules and regulations which will govern your stay at the Institute.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Location and Transport to Forest Industries Training Institute

Forest Industries Training Institute (FITI) is located at VIWANDA ROAD opposite Tanzania Leather Company, Moshi Municipal. It is approximately to be two kilometers from Moshi Municipality Central Bus Stand. After arriving at the bus stand you can hire a registered taxi, currently at Tshs. 3,000/= to Tshs. 5,000/= in case you may need the service.

2. Arrival

You should arrive at FITI on 21st October, 2018. Please make your own travel arrangements to enable you to travel to Moshi. You are required to meet all travel expenses on your own and there is no refund/reimbursement.

3. Registration

You will be required to register yourself officially with the institute at the **Registrar Office**. The registration will take place on 22nd – 26th October 2018 and after these date they will no registration

For registration purposes, you are required to bring the following:

- a. Original O-level certificate for form four
- b. Original O-level and A-level certificates for form six
- c. Original O-level and NTA 5 Award certificates for NTA 5 holder
- d. Birth certificates
- e. Joining instructions
- f. Bank paying slip for the following;
 - i. Half of the training fee i.e. Tshs 400,000/=
 - ii. Tshs 270,000/= for hostel (Accommodation) if you have applied for hostel and informed that you have secured the place (The list will available in the website during the second week of October 2018).

Failure to adhere to a - f above, will result in cancellation of admission to the Institute.

Please also note that presentation of forged certificates will result in cancellation of admission and legal measures taken against the culprits. No student will be registered after two weeks from the date of the opening of the Institute.

4. Orientation Week

Orientation of new students will be done from 23rd – 27th October 2018. All students are required to participate fully in the orientation programme. Further information about this programme will be given to you on your arrival.

5. Accommodation

Hostels (accommodation) for students is limited and competitive. Students who applied for hostel when filling the application form, the list will available in the website during the second week of October 2018.

(a) Bedding

The Institute does not supply students with bed linen. You are required to bring the following items:

- (i) One pillow
- (ii) One blanket
- (iii) Two bed sheets
- (iv) One mosquito net

(b) Keys

Each room has a key, you will share it with your roommates. Keys should be kept carefully, if the keys will be lost you will be required to replace the keys at your own cost. Keys must be returned to the Registrar of students when the students are leaving for holiday.

NB: The institute has no facilities for students with children/infants

(c) Cleanliness of rooms

The task of cleaning and keeping the room in a good condition is yours. Cleaners will only clean the corridor, toilets and bathrooms.

(d) Meal services

The institute has a cafeteria for meal services. Every student will buy meals at his/her own cost depending on personal preference. It is strictly forbidden for any student to take food to the hostel, cook or boil water in the room.
